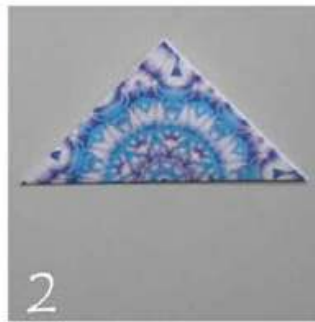
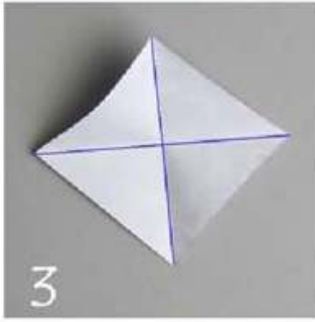




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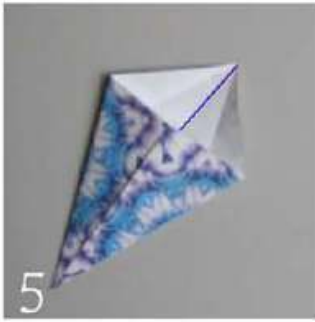
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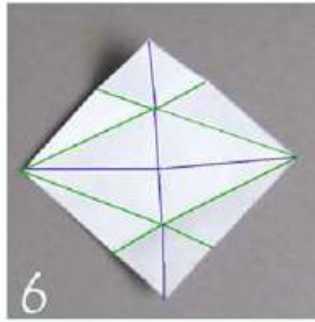
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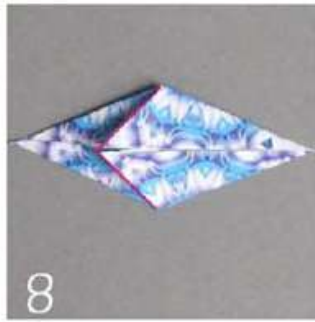
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OPEN ROSETTE

1. Cut out a folding square as accurately as possible, leaving no borders.
2. Fold it corner to opposite corner keeping the image on the outside. Open and fold again using the other opposite corners.
3. Open it and turn over. The folds should look like the blue lines in the picture.
4. Using one of the fold lines as your centre line, fold the top left corner and the bottom right corner to this centre line making a kite shape with the end pointing to the top right corner.
5. Open it and repeat this fold but this time make the kite shape pointing to the bottom left corner.
6. Open this square and you should have the fold lines in the picture, with the new green fold lines created from making the kites.
7. Fold on the green lines towards the centre lines creating 2 little peaks (outlined in red) one on the top and one on the bottom.
8. Fold these peaks flat to the left.
9. Turn over. You should have a diamond shape.
10. Take the left point of the diamond shape and fold the top layer of it half way so that it sits over the right side of the diamond. (This will expose the back side of your peaks on the left side creating a kite shape again.)
11. Take the right corner point of this same triangle and fold it again half way so the point of it touches the left point of the kite. You have just created a petal for your open rosette.
12. Repeat the process to create a second petal and then line it up to the right of the first one as in the picture approximately 1 cm above the first one. Glue them both down, but only the ends of the petal tips, as you will need to add a centre later.
13. Repeat this process 6 more time, to create a rosette with 8 petals and glue them down at the ends.
14. Cut out the centre of another folding square and slot it into the centre to complete your flower. You can now glue down petals as you would like, making them flat, or leaving them more 3 dimensional.
